

## FIVE SECONDS

### INTRODUCTION

Thank you for your kind and patient attention to a very long lesson last week. In return, I'd like to present a five second sermon at this time.

### I. SECOND COVENANT

#### A. **Hebrews 8:7**

The first covenant, the one God gave Israel through Moses, was not intended to be permanent.

#### B. **Isaiah 55:3; Hebrews 13:20-21**

While the first covenant was in force, God offered to establish an everlasting one. We can be complete in this covenant.

#### C. **Hebrews 7:22; 8:6**

The covenant of Christ is better than the old one because it was established upon better promises.

#### D. **Hebrews 10:9-10**

The existence of this covenant shows that the old one is done away.

### II. SECOND MAN

#### A. **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:47**

Whereas Adam was the first man, Christ is the second man.

#### B. **1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:22, 45**

The actions of the first man introduced death, but the actions of the second man provide life everlasting.

#### C. **1<sup>st</sup> John 5:11**

Christ gives life.

### III. SECOND COMMANDMENT

A. **Matthew 22:37-40**

The second commandment, subservient only to the love we must have for God, is to love our neighbors.

B. **Luke 10:25-37**

The second commandment is exemplified by the good Samaritan.

C. **James 2:8-9; Romans 13:9-10**

Through love, we can fulfill the law. This requires that we do no harm to our neighbor.

IV. **SECOND COMING**

A. **Hebrews 9:27-28**

Christ will come again to save those of us who are waiting for Him!

B. **John 14:1-3**

He promised to come again.

C. **Acts 1:9-11**

He will come as He left.

D. **Mark 13:32; 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 3:10**

He will come unexpectedly.

E. **Matthew 16:27; 2<sup>nd</sup> Thessalonians 1:7-9**

He will come to reward the faithful and punish the disobedient.

V. **SECOND DEATH**

A. **Revelation 21:8**

The second death is the ultimate punishment for those guilty of sin.

B. **Revelation 2:11; 20:6**

The second death will have no effect on the obedient.

C. **Romans 6:23**

In contrast to death as the punishment for sin, life is offered through Christ.
